Family Ministry Programs

Our Children's Ministry Coordinator, Kate Littler, teaches Sunday School with Lita, offering nursery care each week during worship with creative crafts, activities, interactive programming, games, science experiments, and creative crafts.

Youth Program

OUTREACH

ESG Little Free Pantry

Welcome Baskets (Oct/Nov)

ESG Outreach and the North Toronto Cluster of churches create Welcome Baskets for homeless people who have been living in local shelters but are transitioning to permanent housing.

Collection days and sorting always need volunteers and drivers to deliver items to the different agencies.
